Pioneering Diving Support Vessels classed with IRS launched

testimony another Atmanirbhar (self-reliance) in Defence, two Diving Support Vessels (DSVs) being built underclass of Indian Register of Shipping (IRS), has recently been launched by Hindustan Shipyard Limited (HSL) in Vishakhapatnam, India.

The two diving support ships, Nistar and Nipun, are 118.4m-long, and 22.8m-wide and have a displacement of 9,350t. The Indian Navy will deploy the two vessels to carry out deepsea diving operations along with search and rescue missions, sustained patrolling, and helicopter operations at sea.
