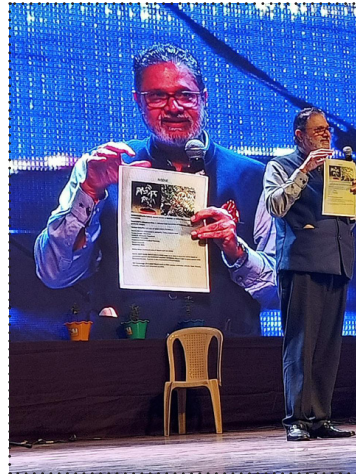
students at large as both associations supported the event.

Biden Warns of Starvation If Russia Cancels UN Grain Ship Deal

The European Union on Sunday 30 Oct called on Russia to reverse its decision to pull out of a U.N.-brokered grain deal, a move that undermined

efforts to ease a global food crisis, and that Ukraine said Moscow had planned well in advance. U.S. President Joe Biden called the move "purely outrageous", saying it would increase starvation.

Moscow suspended its participation in the Black Sea deal on Saturday, effectively cutting shipments from Ukraine, one of the world's top
