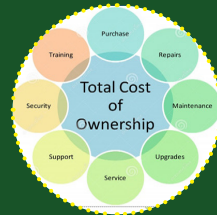

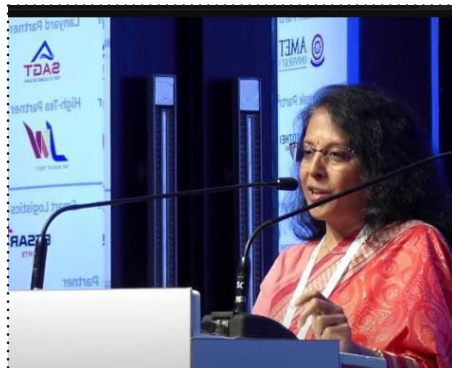
## • Most Diverse Board Award:
