graduates to enable them to prepare tax and TDS returns and Tax Payers' Lounge to showcase all taxpayer services under one roof, which has been awarded for 7 consecutive years by the ITPO. His contribution to public service has been recognized almost every year since 2007 by the CBDT, GoI.

He received three Finance Minister's commendations on the 150th year of Income Tax in 2012, the highest by any IRS officer. He is also a recipient of the G-Files Governance Award, 2014 for exceptional contribution to Public Service.

He has led several reforms in D.G. Shipping including the introduction of 35 e-Governance modules, a complete revamp of maritime training, transparency in the license and approval process, revamping of old

Acts, etc, the introduction of e-learning, online exit exams, issue of digital certificates and complete automation of the office of D.G. Shipping and implementation of ease of doing business.

His management of COVID-19, including safe repatriation and crewchange of more than 250,000 seafarers, has been greatly appreciated & acknowledged by the international community, including the Nautical Institute and International Transport Federation.

He leads Indian Delegations in the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) and Contact Group on Piracy off the Coast of Somalia (CGPCS).
