the future, which will continue to inspire and motivate the budding talent in the maritime industry.

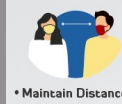
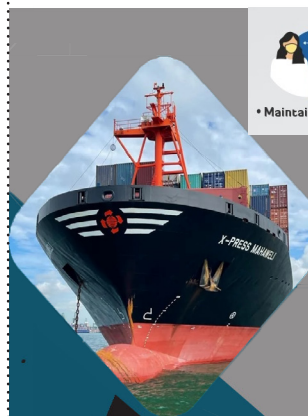

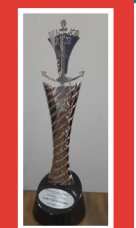
