**N**ational Union of Seafarers of India (NUSI) had publicized the "Life at Sea 2023" photo competition organized by the ITF Seafarers Trust, UK. Since 2020 the ITF Seafarers' Trust project has opened a window into the real-life experiences of seafarers at sea and highlighted their vital, often unnoticed, role in the global economy.

The first prize was the UK 1,000 pounds. To encourage all ranks of Indian seafarers, NUSI had announced an additional NUSI prize of Rs. 25,000/- for any Indian seafarer who would win any prize in the competition.

The winners have been announced by the ITF Seafarers Trust, UK as per the final list compiled by an expert professional panel.

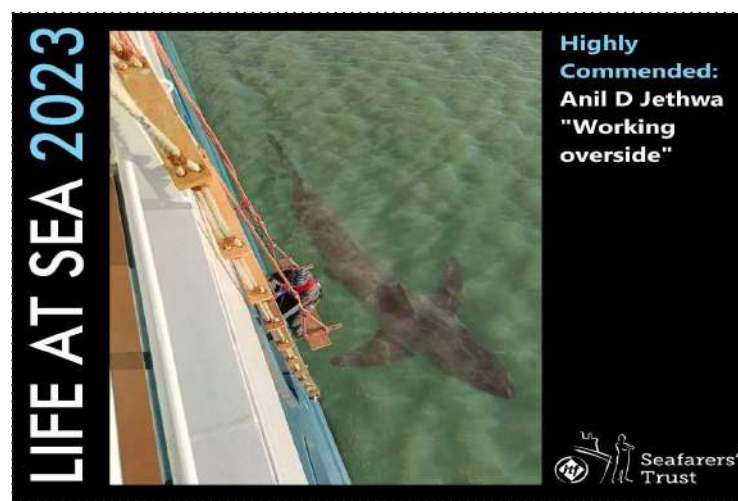
