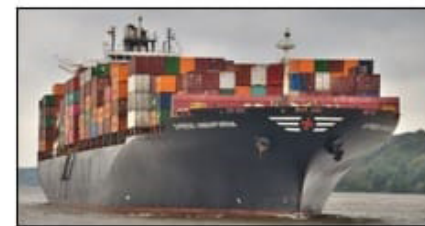

Identifying a problem or business opportunity; gathering relevant information on a specific situation; identifying possible changes or enhancements for the benefit of the forwarder or the client; evaluating the information and drawing one's own conclusions; deciding what action should be taken; making reasoned and costed recommendations; quality of innovation and initiative; description and valuation of the situation, discussion of problems, opportunities,

faults, relevant issues, benefits, costs, etc. And, thereby, the participants would get the opportunity to have international acquaintances for their company as well as their own career building in the logistics domain.

was held at Arakkonam between 11-12 Mar 2022

Special postal cover released

A special postal cover was released commemorating and recognising INS Rajali's stellar milestone of 'Three

Decades of Excellence in Maritime Reconnaissance' by Vice Adm Puneet Kumar Bahl Commandant-Indian Naval Academy, in the presence of Vice Adm Dilip Deshpande (Retd), Rear Adm Deepak Bansal, VSM, Asst Chief of Naval Staff (Air Materiel). Post Master General, India Post, Chennai and other distinguished guests.

The seminar enabled cross-pollination of ideas on strategic public-private partnership for achieving self-reliance under the 'Atmanirbhar' initiative of the Government of India and provided the ideas and avenues for setting up of Maintenance Repair Overhaul facilities for Maritime Reconnaissance Aircraft. 15 papers were presented during the seminar which also included the participation of reputed foreign OEMs, DPSUs and MROs viz., M/s Boeing, M/s General Atomics, M/s HAL, M/s AIESL and M/s Airworks. Addressing the participants of the seminar, the Chief Guest emphasised

the need for foreign OEMs to tap indigenous industry and naval resources to develop a joint work model for the sustenance of the aircraft fleet to optimise the maintenance requirements under the aegis of 'Atmanirbhar Bharat'.
