
To commemorate the 24th year of their existence, Annual Cultural program was held on 30thApril, 2022 evening at Gyan Mancha auditorium, Kolkata,

Chief guest of the evening Mr. Janab Firhad Hakim, Mayor of Kolkata & Minister in charge of Transport, Municipal affairs & Housing, Government of West Bengal, could not be present as he had urgent and pressing commitments.

Shri Saumitra Ghosh, President of the Eastern Zonal Association of **Engineers** Marine (EZAME), in his key note address, welcomed all the guests of honour, surveyors from maritime administration, members from the institute of marine engineers, Kolkata chapter, faculty and engine cadets from marine engineering and research institute, Kolkata and present 300 guests for attending the association's 24th annual day celebration and prize distribution ceremony.

addressing the audience, the Shri P.K. Gangopadhyay, who is a key observer of **Eastern Zonal Association** of Marine Engineer's activities, spoke about the SCI's stake in inland & coastal shipping. Inland & coastal shipping ltd (ICSL), wholly owned subsidiary is headquartered in SCI's Kolkata office. It was incorporated in 2016 after Maritime India summit for undertaking/ providing transport services through inland waterways, coastal shipping and end to end logistics.

ICSL and IWAI (Inland Waterways Authority of India) signed a historic memorandum of understanding on 22nd jan'21 for operations and management of three IWAI cargo vessels and already some vessels are plying in national waterways NW-2.

ICSL is in the process of establishing scheduled liner services in national waterways NW-1 (Haldia/ Varanasi). Kolkata to One vessel successfully completed voyage from Kolkata to Patna with containerized cargo. Subsequently, **ICSL** intends to connect inland waterways with coastal shipping. All these services through the rivers would not only be economical, but also reduce carbon footprint.

Capt Abhijit Ghosh, in his speech highlighted the important role of mariners in shipping in moving very essential logistics when the whole world is in disarray due to pandemic. Mariners served beyond the end of their original contracts and unable to be repatriated due to air travel restrictions. He also elaborated the major and difficult role of the Kolkata Port Trust towards

maintaining nationa waterways navigable.

Shri Amar Singh Thakur in his speech highlighted the role of the Maritime Union of India. He emphasised that MUI always give top priority to seafarers' issues. According to merit it's taken up with relevant authorities, which include ship owners, ship managers, government of India, overseas unions, embassies. consulates, Directorate General of Shipping, GOI.As a general secretary, he ensures that all welfare facilities are accessible to officers and their families, be it holiday homes, financial assistance related or towards medical expenses, injury and unfortunate demise.He has established a women's wing to ensure that wives of officers too are part of merchant shipping family. It functions as a platform for spouses of male seafarers when they

are away or at home with their families.

Towards award ceremony, mementos and prizes were distributed to 66 building fund (2012) donors in gratitude. Also awards were distributed to 3 members for their outstanding work.

Post awards ceremony, it was followed by a muchawaited cultural program whereby audience was captivated and entertained by the performance of noted saxophonist Shri Sanjoy Naskar and his band. It was followed by beautiful rendition by Ms Preeti Basu and Shri Gurjeet Singh accompanied by their Jhankar Band. Ms. TamaliGhosh was the event anchor.

Thunder shower during the show brought much needed relief of the sweltering heat wave and turned it into more awesome and memorable night. Full event also broadcasted live by "Samay Kolkata" TV Channel.
