
from Mr. Barguzer during his service at various positions in DG Shipping.

Shipping Office, Mumbai; (3) Assistant Director-General of Shipping in D G Shipping Mumbai ;(4) Commissioner Seamen's Provident Fund Organisation (SPFO); (5) Deputy Director-General of Shipping in D G Shipping.

Mr. Barguzer was nominated by the Govt. as Member Secretary in the Committee of Management of Seafarer's Welfare Fund Society (SWFS), an autonomous society under the administrative control of the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. He has been the longest-serving Member Secretary in the SWFS.

In his retirement, the maritime fraternity will miss a valuable officer, however, it is not the end but the beginning of a beautiful journey for Mr. Subhash Barguzer.


