Capt Gyanendra is one among these 75 enthusiastic riders, selected from among 500+ applicants. Always young at heart, an avid road traveller, adventurous and patriotic, Capt. Gyanendra Singh has lived the first 11 years of his life in this region, he says "This would be like a homecoming".

Well known for his passion for the profession, and the charisma and charm he spreads at all social occasions, Capt Gyanendra has now embarked on this 9 Day journey to the North East, with the intent to spread Maritime Awareness in the most pristine and unexplored lands of India.

His heartfelt message, "Ours is the most unique profession. People tasted lockdown now – work-eat-sleep in the confines of limited space. Seafarers have

lived in lockdown forever and will continue to do so. But they do it happily, with the love for the entire world, serving every nation without discretion. Remember we could survive this lockdown because this breed called "Seafarers" who work at sea – away from home and family for months together, continued to work in even more strenuous conditions, with more


The MoS asserted that "northeast is something to be showcased. There are eight states with 166 different tribes and traditions, which are protected by the constitution this country."
